RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to enter into a legally binding agreement to memorialize their mutual rights and obligations concerning their marriage; and WHEREAS, the Parties intend this Agreement to be enforceable under the laws of the United States.

1. PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT
