Section 1 – Engagement

Artist hereby engages Producer to provide music production services, including recording, mixing, and mastering, as described in this Agreement. Producer accepts such engagement and agrees to render services in a professional and timely manner.

Section 2 – Services Provided

Producer shall provide all necessary services, equipment, personnel, and facilities to produce the musical recordings (the “Recordings”) specified herein. Any additional services beyond the scope must be approved in writing by both parties.

Section 3 – Delivery

Producer agrees to deliver the completed Recordings in a format mutually agreed upon by both parties within a reasonable timeframe following recording sessions. Delivery includes all final mixes and masters.

Section 4 – Compensation

Artist shall pay Producer the agreed Total Fee, payable according to the Payment Schedule outlined above. Late payments shall incur reasonable interest as permitted by law.

Section 5 – Ownership and Rights

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, Producer assigns and transfers to Artist all right, title, and interest in the Recordings, including copyright and all related rights, upon full payment. Producer retains the right to use Recordings for portfolio and promotional purposes, provided no unauthorized commercial use.

Section 6 – Credits

Producer shall be credited as the Producer on all copies and public releases of the Recordings in a manner consistent with industry standards.

Section 7 – Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding any proprietary or sensitive information disclosed during the term of this Agreement.

Section 8 – Representations and Warranties

Each party represents and warrants that it has full authority to enter into this Agreement and that the performance of its obligations will not infringe upon the rights of any third party.

Section 9 – Indemnification

Each party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other from any claims, damages, or liabilities arising out of breach of this Agreement or violation of applicable laws.

Section 10 – Term and Termination

This Agreement shall remain in effect until completion of services unless terminated earlier by mutual consent or for cause, with written notice. Upon termination, Artist shall pay Producer for all services rendered up to the termination date.

Section 11 – Independent Contractor

Producer acts as an independent contractor and not as an employee or agent of Artist. Producer is solely responsible for all taxes and statutory obligations.

Section 12 – Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the applicable state law, without regard to conflict of laws principles.

Section 13 – Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising under this Agreement shall first be subject to mediation before pursuing arbitration or litigation. Venue for disputes shall be in a court of competent jurisdiction within the agreed state.

Section 14 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement, including any exhibits or schedules, constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements or understandings, oral or written.

Section 15 – Amendments

Any amendments or modifications to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties.

Section 16 – Notices

All notices required under this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered by hand, certified mail, or electronic mail to the addresses specified above.

Section 17 – Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for failure or delay in performance due to causes beyond their reasonable control, including natural disasters, acts of government, or other unforeseeable events.

Section 18 – Assignment

Neither party may assign or transfer its rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of

the other party.

Section 19 – Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 20 – Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together constitute one and the same instrument.
