Legal Compliance and Enforceability:

This Agreement is intended to be legally binding and enforceable under the laws of the United States and the applicable state jurisdiction. If any provision is found unenforceable, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.

Entire Agreement:

This document constitutes the entire agreement between the parties regarding custody and visitation and supersedes any prior agreements, understandings, or representations.
